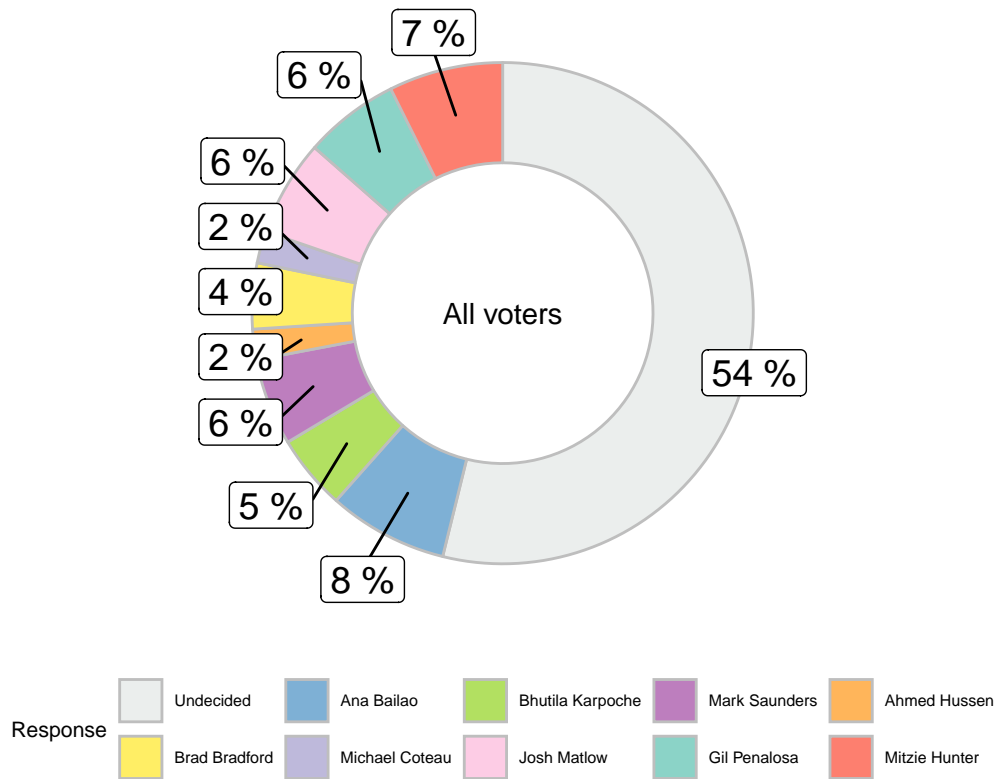
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Sunday, February 19th to Sunday, February 19th, 2023, among a sample of 1701 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Toronto. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Toronto. The poll was conducted in English and Mandarin.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2.4% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding.
